### Job Description

Position: Lead Summer Camp Counselor – College Park, GA

**General Responsibilities:** A Summer Camp Counselor is responsible for serving children attending a summer day camp for underserved students in College Park, GA.

**Profile:** A Summer Camp Counselor should be a blend between \*60% people skills and 40% task personality traits. They should have an intense focus on detail, timeliness, servant leadership, communication, customer service, flexibility, and follow-through. A Summer Camp Counselor provides intentional, proactive leadership and is required to provide hands-on attention to the details of summer camp operations and administrative duties as required. \* Relationship is key (60%) but camp is more than “hanging out” with kids...

### Job Description

- Arrive on time, set-up for camp. Note: We do not have anyone who can sub for you!
- Interface with parents, park management, staff, volunteers, campers and sponsors.
- Plan and Coordinate daily curriculum, first aid, field trips, lunch and all adventure activities.

- 1-2 years of summer day camp experience preferred.
- A Summer Camp Counselor must have a deep and growing relationship with Jesus Christ with their daily focus on Him as Lord and Savior.

**Fitness Demands: A very high level of fitness is required for this position and a PFT Test must be completed prior to hire.**

While performing the duties of this job, an employee is regularly required to stand for 2+ hours; must have the ability to lift and carry 20-50 lbs. when unloading supplies, climb multiple sets of stairs or bleachers on a regular basis, exercise/play in the 95' GA heat for 3-5hours, crawl through caves, ride a mountain bike and the ability to walk 5-6 miles on hard surfaces or mountain trails.

2. A description of your fitness plan detailing how you are currently training and improving your fitness level, your diet and nutrition regiment to prepare you for 10-12 hour days in the 95' summer heat.

3. Confirmation you have a valid SS#.
4. Confirmation you have a valid Driver's License.
5. Confirm your ability to commit to work Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.
6. Confirm your ability to work on Fridays from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.
7. A willingness to work from home on Saturday to prepare for the next week.
8. Your availability the third week of July for our summer ending overnight reward trip. 8 days 7 nights to Big Canoe, GA / GIRLS House / BOYS House
9. Your availability on the weekends in May to participate in training. (Paid Training)
10. Two references – 1 work / 1 character
